- > Ensuring that your child attends school regularly, including avoiding taking children away on holiday in term time.
- Contacting the school whenever your child is absent, giving the reason and approximate length of absence.
- Making balanced judgements about whether your child is well enough to be in school and cooperating with us by keeping them off if they are unwell and may pass on sickness to other vulnerable children. (Please remember that 48 hours after the last bout is required before a child returns to school after sickness or diarrhoea).
- Helping your child prepare for the school day by ensuring that your child has everything they need for the day.
- > Attending Parents' meetings, including Annual Reviews, to discuss progress.
- Treating staff with respect.
