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reconnoissance is a concern. Budding terrorists conduct research as part of their attack planning. Signs to look out for include: loitering in restricted or non public areas. Observing or photographing entrances, exit exits, seek cameras, security features or staff. Asking unusual questions. Hiding their faces or using a disguise. Vehicles retracing routes, parked out of place or abandoned.

Our pupils are especially susceptible to Hostile Reconnaissance due to their challenges with recognising and understanding unacceptable social behaviours.
